

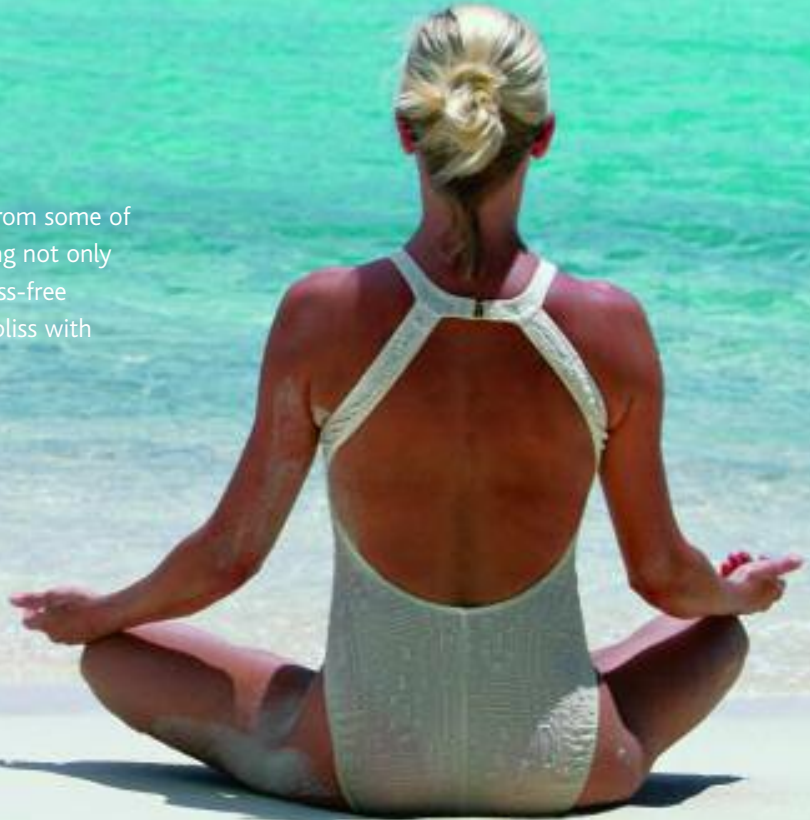
Honeymoon Beauty

"I could never see the value in putting your makeup on for an hour when you could be on the beach with your new husband," says Dena Wiseman, makeup artist for Bodyography (bodyography.com) "You want a fresh, clean look on your honeymoon. You want to look polished." Wiseman recommends keeping your honeymoon beauty routine basic and fast. "Bronzing powder and lip gloss are honeymoon essentials," says Wiseman. "Just keep it simple." Freelance makeup artist Paula Jane Hamilton agrees with these basics but also adds black mascara to the list. "Bronzing powder, black mascara and lip gloss will see you through any day, destination and climate. Bronzer is a multipurpose product. You can dust it lightly on cheeks or layer it for more color, then sweep it across your eyelids. Your black mascara can also double as eyeliner for evening. Simply use a liner

brush to apply close to the lash line or smudge out with a cotton swab." Multipurpose seems to be the buzzword of the cosmetic industry these days and with good reason. We work hard for our money and women want to get the most return on our cosmetic investments. "It's all about condensing products," says Caprise Gray, makeup artist with Smashbox Cosmetics (smashbox.com). "You'll want to find products that do more than one thing."
